

### Pence Amendment Possibly Again

Barack Obama has unveiled his proposed Fiscal Year 2011 budget, which continues his pro-abortion agenda. It will continue federal funding for abortion in Washington, DC, initiated last year. It also continues funding the pro-abortion United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), which works with population control officials in China despite China's well-known human rights abuses, including its one-child policy, forced abortions and sterilizations.

Significantly, the 2011 budget requests an increase of approximately \$10 million for a total of \$327,356,000 for the Department of Health and Human Services Title X family planning program, which gives much money to Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion providing chain.

Last year, Congressman Mike Pence (R-IN), offered an amendment to the HHS budget to stop Title X family planning funding from going to Planned Parenthood, which failed in the House 183-247. According to Congressman Pence's office, if House Speaker Nancy Pelosi and her Rules Committee permit amendments to the HHS budget, Congressman Pence intends to offer his amendment again to block any Title X funding to Planned Parenthood because of its abortion activities.

### Resolution Against Federal Abortion Expansion

Wednesday, February 17, the full Ohio Senate voted on SCR 6, an Ohio resolution to urge the U.S. Congress to Prevent Federal Expansion of Abortion. The resolution passed the Senate 21-9, and now goes to the House, a less friendly arena.

Senators Tim Grendell and Steve Buehrer originally introduced the resolution in March 2009. At that time, SCR 6 urged Congress to oppose the pro-abortion Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA) and similar legislation.

After a huge pro-life outcry, pro-abortion forces in Congress did not follow through with FOCA but instead focused on expanding abortion through federal healthcare reform efforts. Thus SCR 6 was amended to urge Congress to oppose any legislation that "increases access to or funding for abortion," including any such provisions in federal healthcare reform legislation.

### Oratory Contest Winner Controversy

Last year Elizabeth Trisler won the Ohio Right to Life and National Right to Life Oratory Contests and was to be honored Feb. 3rd by Ohio Representative John Adams with a proclamation on the House floor. Though such an award is routine, Speaker of the House Armond Budish cancelled this presentation due to the "politically sensitive," nature of the group sponsoring the event.

Additional groups opposed Speaker Budish's decision, including the ACLU. He then reversed his decision and Elizabeth was assured the proclamation would occur. Elizabeth has since shared her pro-life witness on the O'Reilly Factor and Fox & Friends television programs, as well as in print media, but the Ohio House may rewrite the rules to limit such honors.

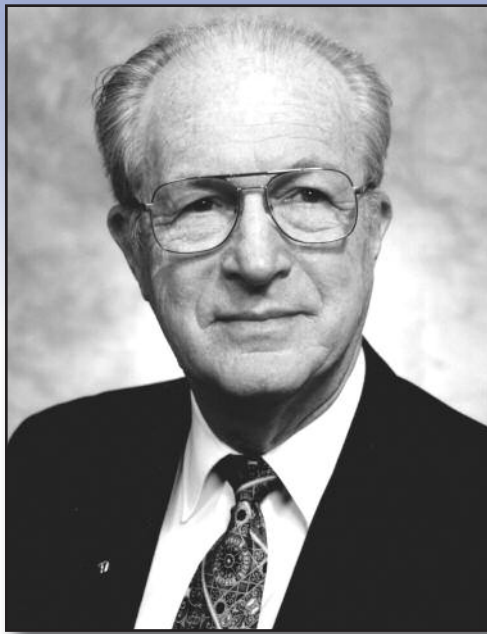

there is always the possibility that fertilization, and thus pregnancy, has not occurred. With Ellaone effective up to five days later, however, if fertilization has occurred the tiny human will be killed. This is not a contraceptive; this is an abortion agent.

**VICTORY IN NEW HAMPSHIRE:** January 13, the New Hampshire House defeated a measure that would have legalized physician assisted-suicide, 242-113. If passed, New Hampshire would have become the fourth state to accept this deadly practice after Oregon, Washington and Montana. Besides legalizing assisted suicide, the bill would have mandated that a terminally ill patient need not be suffering serious symptoms to qualify for assisted suicide. The Euthanasia Prevention Task Force worked hard to defeat the measure and the Catholic Diocese of Manchester strongly opposed it. Not surprisingly, the mainstream media ignored this result.

**TEENS OPPOSE ABORTION:** A nationwide Girl Scout Research Institute survey on the Beliefs and Moral Values of America's Children, questioned 3,263 girls and boys 3rd-12th grades on issues such as ethics, diversity, civic involvement, and peer pressure. The survey revealed that girls are less likely than boys to recommend abortion to their friends. It also found that overall, less than 10% of all surveyed said they would ever suggest an abortion.

**PREGNANCY OUTCOMES IN 2005:** Statistics from 2005 show that non-Hispanic white live births equal 2,303,000 with 415,000 induced abortions. Hispanic live births were 986,000 with 263,000 induced abortions. Non-Hispanic blacks

listed 587,000 live births with 452,000 Black abortions. Now note that the total number of Black deaths from all causes (excluding abortion) in the U.S. in the same year was 293,000.

**MARRIAGE PENALTY:** *The Wall Street Journal*, commenting on Barack Obama's proposed health insurance legislation, said "For an unmarried couple with income of \$25,000 each, combined premiums would be capped at \$3,076 per year. If the couple gets married, with a combined income of \$50,000, their annual premium jumps to \$5,160. This is a direct penalty for getting married of \$2,084 a year."

**ABSTINENCE-ONLY EDUCATION:** Abstinence-only education equals decreased promiscuity. In the *Archives of the Pediatric & Adolescent Medicine's* February issue, abstinence-only intervention is linked to a lower rate of sexual involvement among African-American pre-teens.

**SUSAN B. ANTHONY, PRO-LIFE FEMINIST:** Much is said these days about the radical feminist, pro-abortion agenda. One of the true leading feminists of all times, however, was Susan B. Anthony. Her face is on a U.S. dollar coin. Here is what she said about abortion (July 1869), "I deplore the horrible crime of child murder. No matter what the motive, love of ease or the desire to save from suffering the unborn innocent, the woman is awfully guilty who commits the deed. It will burden her conscience for life. It will burden her soul in death. But, Oh! Thrice guilty is he who drove her to the desperation, which impelled her to the crime."

**A NEW BALL GAME:** The earth-shattering victory by Senator-elect Scott Brown (R-MA) may spell defeat of Barack Obama's 2000-plus pages socialized medicine scheme. Brown stated, "One thing is very clear as I travel across this state. People do not want the trillion dollar health care plan that is being forced on the American people. This bill is not being debated openly and fairly. It will raise taxes. It will hurt Medicare. It will destroy jobs, and it will run our nation deeper into debt."

**PENTAGON OFFICIALS REQUIRE PLAN B:** Pentagon officials have issued a requirement that the abortifacient Plan B, morning-after pill, be stocked in all U.S. military bases, domestic and abroad.

**MCCAIN-FEINGOLD LAW REVERSAL:** January 21, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that corporations, labor unions, and other groups can directly spend money on political campaigns. This is a stunning reversal of federal campaign finance laws. This strikes down most of what is left of the McCain-Feingold Campaign Finance Law.

**NEW MORNING AFTER PILL:** Ellaone, also known as Ulipristal, is a new pill said to "prevent" pregnancy up to five days after intercourse. With the older "Plan B" pill used 24 hours after sexual activity
