WHY THE LINK BETWEEN ABORTION AND BREAST CANCER?

Last month, we acquainted you with the Abortion Breast Cancer Resolution that Rep. Jean Schmidt (R) Clermont County introduced in the Ohio House of Representatives. Her resolution would create a task force to study whether abortion causes a greater risk for breast cancer. Several experts testified before the House Health Committee on this topic. What follows are excerpts of that testimony.

Some form of estrogen overexposure characterizes most known risk factors for breast cancer. For example, women who reach puberty at an early age or menopause at a late age or who have fewer or no children, experience more menstrual cycles. Therefore, they are exposed to higher levels of estradiol (a form of estrogen) and have a higher risk of breast cancer. Women who have more children and who nurse them, on the other hand, experience a

reduction in the number of menstrual cycles and reduce their risk of breast cancer by doing so. Organized medicine does not dispute these facts.

However, women are not being told that abortion increases breast cancer risk. Estradiol causes cells in the breast to multiply; thus making a woman's breasts swell upon pregnancy. By the end of the first trimester, the estradiol level has increased by 2000% over what it was at conception. Estradiol causes both normal and pre-cancerous cells to multiply. If the pregnancy is carried to term, a second process called differentiation takes place. Differentiation shapes cells into milk-producing cells, and this second process shuts off the cell multiplication process. This takes place at approximately 32 weeks gestation. If the pregnancy is aborted, the woman is left with more undifferentiated, and therefore cancer-vulnerable, cells than she had before

ABORTION HURTS WOMEN

Would you want a stranger to drive you at breakneck speed on a dark and unfamiliar road? Would you send your teenage daughter on such a trip? Every year for the past three decades thousands of teen girls and young women in the Greater Cincinnati area taking similar risks.

Many are encouraged, even pressured to do so. They are told to let a stranger blindly probe their bodies to remove their developing babies. These strangers work fast because time is money.

Some of the risks and damage caused by abortion are listed here to confirm the fact that abortion hurts all women in some ways and many women severely. The following points are documented in greater detail on the web site: www.afterabortion.org.

Immediate Complications. Approximately 10% of women undergoing elective abortion will suffer immediate complications, of which approximately one-fifth (2%) are considered life threatening. The nine most common major complications which can occur at the time of an abortion are: infection, excessive bleeding, embolism, ripping or perforation of the uterus, anesthesia complications, convulsions, hemorrhage, cervical injury, and endotoxic shock. The most common "minor" complications include: infection, bleeding, fever, second degree burns, chronic abdominal pain, vomiting, gastro-intestinal disturbances, and Rh sensitization.

Increased Risks for Women Seeking Multiple Abortions. In general, the medical studies used to prepare this summary report known risk factors for women who undergo a single abortion. These same studies show that women who have multiple abortions face a much greater risk of experiencing these same complications. This point is especially noteworthy since approximately 45% of all abortions are for repeat aborters.

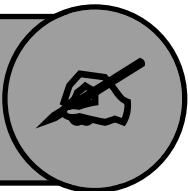

DR. WILLKE WRITES



INCUMBENT PROTECTION ACT: The correct name for the so-called Campaign Reform Act should be the Incumbent Politicians' Protection Act. We have no organizational opinion on

the much-touted efforts to control "soft" money in campaigns (although it does seem that publication of such contributions the very next day on the web might solve the problem). We, however, have a serious fundamental concern about its violation of freedom of speech. If the President signs this act as it goes into conference committee, it will make it a federal crime for right to life groups to publish the results of candidate surveys prior to elections. As you know, it has been the custom of pro-life groups nationally to poll and then report on the simple facts of how candidates stand, in answer to questionnaires on issues. Further, pro-life groups have routinely reported on how candidates vote on issues relating to life. This legislation specifically would make it a federal crime for your right to life group to publish such information prior to an election. For the overwhelming majority of people this information is of interest only in the couple of months before an election, and it is during this specific time that pro-life groups will be muzzled.

The only groups that are not forbidden to report in such a way are the political parties themselves, political action committees, and most importantly, the liberal, radical press and TV. There are no limits on what they can say, do or report. Yes, friends, this is properly named the Incumbent Politician's Protection Act.



NO PLANNED PARENTHOOD IN COLORADO: Colorado has a law forbidding any tax money from subsidizing an organization that does abortions. Accordingly,

Planned Parenthood had set up a separate corporation to do abortions, and had grouped their other functions in their original corporation. Even so, the state health department has announced that it will cut off this year's \$381,956 of taxpayer funds to Planned Parenthood of Rocky Mountains. You see, an audit of the organization has revealed that one corporation was subsidizing rent for the other corporation, the one that was performing abortions.



FIRST AMENDMENT VOTED DOWN:

During the debate in the U.S. House of Representatives, over the misnamed Campaign Reform Act (actually the Incumbent Politicians Protection Act), the following amendment was offered by Rep. Henry Hyde. "Nothing in the bill may be construed to abridge first amendment rights, specifically the freedom of speech and the press, the right to peaceably assemble, and the right to petition the government for a redress of government." Did these esteemed and honorable servants of the citizens of this nation realize that they were voting on the exact wording of the first amendment to the United States Constitution? And they voted this wording down.

OHIO PARTIAL BIRTH—U.S. INTERVENTION:

The U.S. Department of Justice, under Attorney General John Ashcroft, has entered the court case regarding Ohio's ban on partial birth abortions. This was tentatively struck down by a federal district court, and is now before the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals. The U.S. Department of Justice brief argues that Ohio's law is different from the Nebraska law that was struck down by the U.S. Supreme Court in *Stenberg vs. Carhart*, and that it, therefore, is constitutional. This is the first time since 1992, when the first President Bush was in office, that the White House has stepped in to back an abortion restriction in court. Bills with different and more vague wording were passed on two occasions during Clinton's terms; he vetoed the bills both times. Partial birth abortion, as our readers know, is killing a baby during delivery. Records show that 90% of these are physically normal infants and that half of them are capable of surviving outside the womb, if given adequate care. These abortions are overwhelmingly elective killing of normal, viable babies during delivery.

ARIZONA ABORTIONIST JAILED:

Brian Finkel, 51, a well-known abortionist in Arizona, has been returned to jail. He was arrested in October and charged by the county attorney of sexually abusing 9 patients. He has since been indicted on charges of molesting 26 others. This has received quite a bit of publicity and in response to that more than 100 additional women have since called the district attorney's office alleging similar abuse.

NEW YORK—A VICIOUS ATTACK: The strongly pro-abortion Attorney General of New York, Elliott Spitzer, has begun a campaign to, if possible, close all pregnancy help centers in that state. He appears to be following a script that was recently published by the National Abortion Rights Action League entitled, *A Step By Step Guide – Unmasking Fake Clinics*. He claims that he's conducting an investigation to find out whether "certain businesses" in N.Y. have engaged in repeated fraudulent or illegal acts in violation of state law, including engaging in false advertising and deceptive business practices. Translate that into saying, these centers do pregnancy testing and counseling. This may be construed as the official practice of medicine without a license. If he can make this charge stick, he could close them down. If he can't close them, at least he would like to bankrupt them. He has subpoenaed more than three dozen such centers and has demanded that they produce, almost immediately, various documents including copies of all ads and promotional literature, brochures and all documents sent to potential donors, all training materials, guidelines and scripts used to respond to client inquiries, copies of policies and procedures, minutes of meetings, client referral records, etc. He even admits that several of these centers have never had any complaints lodged against them, so he's on a fishing expedition. His minimum hope is to drain the centers of their funding. His hope also is that it will scare the volunteer staff of housewives, retirees, teachers, nurses, and others into abandoning their work with the centers.

In response to this, South Carolina's Attorney General Charlie Condon immediately rose to their defense, castigating him and asking him to drop the investigation. The heavyweight legal defense fund, The American Center of Law and Justice, has responded by offering to represent the clinics. Catholic bishops have done the same. In Congress, Rep. Bob Schaffer (R-CO) has introduced a resolution in support. To date he has 56 co-sponsors, but sadly only one from New York.

ABSTINENCE PROGRAMS WORK: In Washington, DC, there are more abortions than live births; therefore, a successful abstinence program in DC public schools is of great interest. It is called "Best Friends". It was launched in a mostly black middle school. In 1995 the program was evaluated. 26% of the girls in the high school became pregnant before graduating. Among those in the Best Friends group, only 1% became pregnant. The same was true of loss of virginity by the tenth grade. This occurred in 63% of the girls in the school compared to only 5% of girls in the Best Friends group. This program has been reproduced in schools around the country, now enrolling over 5,000 girls in 99 public schools in 14 states.



FREE SPEECH VICTORY FOR PRO-LIFERS: In January, the James Madison Center won an important victory for non-profit ideologic corporations such as right to life groups. The U.S. Court of Appeals for the 4th Circuit held that a prior federal ban on corporate contributions directly to candidates was unconstitutional. It ruled that North Carolina Right to Life, which brought the case, not only could continue to do independent expenditures for a candidate, "Without the candidates knowledge or cooperation" as it has in the past, but could now also make direct contributions to a candidate, subject to the existing \$1,000 limitation for each election. James Bopp Esq., who has amassed an amazing record of pro-life wins against a belligerent and antagonistic Federal Election Commission, was again the victor in this case.

BUSH PROPOSES FETAL COVERAGE: The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, has announced a proposed revision in its regulations concerning the State Children's Insurance Health Program. This federal program provides medical assistance for a low-income "child." This applies to children under age 19. This proposed change will allow a state to recognize unborn children as among those who are eligible for coverage under the program. This will allow the baby and the mother to receive adequate pre-natal care. Prior to this, such care was only available with a waiver, which was obtained only after a lengthy and often questionable bureaucratic process. This will expedite care for both mother and child. Thank you Mr. Bush.



ULTRASOUND SAVES BABIES? In a recent interview, Thomas Glesner, President of the National Institute of Family and Life Advocates, was asked about the success of ultrasound in persuading women to not abort their babies. He estimated that only 25% to 50% of "abortion minded" women who received counseling (but no ultrasound) would decide to keep their babies, the others would get abortions. He noted one center that had a "huge positive impact." Without ultrasound they saved 20%, with ultrasound 95%. Dr. Peggy Hartshorn, Director of Heartbeat International, in Columbus, Ohio said that as many as 60% to 90% who view their baby on ultrasound change their mind and decide not to abort.

It was reported in May of 2000 however, that Planned Parenthood claimed that half of the women going into their abortion clinics got ultrasound exams, but of these women who were abortion minded, only 5% decided to continue the pregnancy. Why this strange phenomena? Answer—these clinics prohibit the patient from viewing the screen and these women do not see their own baby on ultrasound. No mystery here.

ABORTION DRUG GIVEN—WOMAN

DIES: Cytotec (misoprostol) is the second drug used for chemical abortions. It is used with RU 486 and with Methotrexate. It is also

used late in pregnancy, however, neither of these uses has been approved by its manufacturer, the G. D. Searle company, which only approves it for treating peptic ulcers. The company's drug literature warns, in bold type, against the use of Cytotec to induce abortion or to induce labor. 34-year-old Margaret O'Connor, while in labor, was given the drug to hurry and complete the delivery. It caused rupture of her uterus, she went into shock and died. A long disputed lawsuit by her husband has just been settled in Portland, OR. Figures from the Food and Drug Administration report 30 cases of ruptured uteri related to its use. In 8 of these, the child died; in this case, the mother died.

CHILD CUSTODY PROTECTION ACT, AGAIN: The House Subcommittee has once again approved a pro-life bill that would make it a crime for a non-parent to take a minor across state lines to obtain an abortion, if that minor's home state has a law requiring parental notification or consent. This is the third time this has been passed in the U.S. House. The Sub-committee Chairman, Steve Chabot, Congressman from Cincinnati, said: This bill seeks to protect the health and safety of young girls, as well as the rights of parents to be involved in the medical decisions of their minor daughters. It prevents valid and constitutional state involvement laws from being circumvented. Congress, he said, is well within its authority to insure that the channels of interstate commerce are not used to frustrate the policy goals of such state laws.

UNFPA MONEY FROZEN: After a hard fought legislative battle, the U.S. Congress had approved \$34,000,000 to be given to the United Nations Fund for Population Activity. This bill contained a clause that the dispersal of the money required approval of the President. Recent congressional hearings and testimony had shown once more that the

UNFPA was deeply involved in China's coercive abortion and sterilization program. Pro-life authorities pleaded with President Bush not to approve using U.S. taxpayer's money to continue this genocide. In response to this, Bush has announced that he has decided not to decide, he has not approved the use of the funds for now, but reserves the right to change his mind later. He stated, "I haven't decided yet, but I'm keeping all of my options open." Let's hope he doesn't decide for a very long time.

THANK YOU, MR. BUSH: President Bush has announced a 33% increase in funding for "abstinence only" education. During the election campaign, he promised to spend as much promoting abstinence as the government has been spending on programs to educate teens about contraception, so he's making good on his promise. We can quote him: "The only sure fire way to prevent pregnancy is through abstinence."

IRONIC - YES: South Carolina Right to Life is moving into new headquarters. This is news, because for 25 years this had been an abortion chamber. Estimates are that between 20,000 and 30,000 babies had lost their lives in this building—but the abortionist died, no one bought his "practice." The building was purchased by a Christian businessman who renovated the space. Now South Carolina Right to Life is occupying it. Good news!



EMBRYONIC STEM CELLS CAUSE

TUMORS: Researchers at Harvard Medical School and the McLean Hospital in Massachusetts injected embryonic stem cells from

rat embryos into the brains of 19 rats with Parkinson's disease. While there was some alleviation of symptoms, 1 in 4 developed tumors. This demonstrates a major drawback to the use of embryonic stem cells. On the contrary, adult stem cells taken from and returned to the same individual not only eliminate the danger of organ rejection, but also, in experiments so far have not produced tumors.

she was pregnant. This is one of two ways in which abortion causes breast cancer. Delayed first full term pregnancy is the second way abortion can cause this disease, because a full term pregnancy leaves a woman with more milk-producing differentiated cells. This means that she has fewer cancer-vulnerable cells in her breasts than she did before the pregnancy. (Portion of Testimony by Dr. Joel Brind, professor of biology and endocrinology at Baruch College of the City University of New York.)

Dr. Angela Lanfranchi testified, "It is my opinion, based upon professional training, experience, and my study of the relevant peer-related medical literature, that an overwhelming preponderance of evidence indicates induced abortion increases risk of breast cancer. Summarily, interrupting a normal pregnancy with abortion leaves a woman with an increase in the number of undifferentiated breast cells [the Type 1 and 2 lobules] that are more susceptible to carcinogens [estrogen cycles, exogenous estrogen, and environmental carcinogens]. Women considering abortion have a right to be informed about this evidence prior to consenting to the procedure." (Angela Lanfranchi, M.D., clinical professor of surgery at Robert Wood Johnson University Medical School and co-director of the Breast Center at Somerset Medical Center, New Jersey.)

Lower General Health. In a survey of 1428 women, researchers found that pregnancy loss, and particularly losses due to induced abortion, was significantly associated with overall lower health. Multiple abortions correlated to an even lower evaluation of “present health.” While miscarriage was detrimental to health, abortion was found to have a greater correlation to poor health. These findings support previous research which reported that during the year following an abortion women visited their family doctors 80% more for all reasons and 180% more for psychosocial reasons. The authors also found that “if a partner is present and not supportive, the miscarriage rate is more than double and the abortion rate is four times greater than if he is present and supportive. If the partner is absent the abortion rate is six times greater.”

Increased Risks for Teenagers. Teenagers, who account for about 30 percent of all abortions, are also at much higher risk of suffering many abortion related complications, both immediate complications and long-term reproductive damage.

Death. The best record based study of deaths following pregnancy and abortion found that women who abort are approximately four times more likely to die in the following year than women who carry their pregnancies to term.

Beast Cancer. The risk of breast cancer almost doubles after one abortion, and rises even further with two or more abortions.

Cervical, Ovarian, and Liver Cancer. Women with one abortion face a 2.3 relative risk of cervical cancer, compared to non-aborted women, and women with two or more abortions face a 4.92 relative risk. Similar elevated risks of ovarian and liver cancer have also been linked to single and multiple abortions.

Uterine Perforation. Between 2 and 3% of all abortion patients may suffer perforation of their uterus, yet most of these injuries will remain undiagnosed and untreated unless laproscopic visualization is performed. The risk of uterine perforation is increased for women who have previously given birth and for those who receive general anesthesia at the time of abortion. Uterine damage may result in complications in later pregnancies and may eventually evolve into problems requiring a hysterectomy, which itself may result in a number of additional complications and injuries.

Cervical Lacerations. Cervical lacerations requiring sutures occur in at least one percent of first trimester abortions. Lesser lacerations, or micro frac-

tures, which would normally not be treated may also result in long term reproductive damage. Latent post-abortion cervical damage may result in subsequent cervical incompetence, premature delivery, and complications of labor. The risk of cervical damage is greater for teenagers, for second trimester abortions, and when practitioners fail to use laminaria for dilation of the cervix.

Placenta Previa. Abortion increases the risk of placenta previa in later pregnancies (a life threatening condition for both the mother and her wanted pregnancy) by seven to fifteen fold. Abnormal development of the placenta due to uterine damage increases the risk of fetal malformation, perinatal death, and excessive bleeding during labor.

Complications of Labor. Women who had one, two, or more previous induced abortions are, respectively, 1.89, 2.66, or 2.03 times more likely to have a subsequent pre-term delivery, compared to women who carry to term. Prior induced abortion not only increased the risk of premature delivery, it also increased the risk of delayed delivery. Women who had one, two, or more induced abortions are, respectively, 1.89, 2.61, and 2.23 times more likely to have a post-term delivery (over 42 weeks). Pre-term delivery increases the risk of neo-natal death and handicaps.

Ectopic Pregnancy. Abortion is significantly related to an increased risk of subsequent ectopic pregnancies. Ectopic pregnancies, in turn, are life threatening and may result in reduced fertility.

Pelvic Inflammatory Disease. PID is a potentially life threatening disease which can lead to an increased risk of ectopic pregnancy and reduced fertility. Of patients who have a chlamydia infection at the time of the abortion, 23% will develop PID within 4 weeks. Studies have found that 20 to 27% of patients seeking abortion have a chlamydia infection. Approximately 5% of patients who are not infected by chlamydia develop PID within 4 weeks after a first trimester abortion. It is therefore reasonable to expect that abortion providers should screen for and treat such infections prior to an abortion.

Endometriosis. Endometriosis is a post-abortion risk for all women, but especially for teenagers, who are 2.5 times more likely than women 20-29 to acquire Endometriosis following abortion.

Normally, writers do their best to conceal their sources of material—after all, authors want their readers to believe they’ve conceived nearly every original thought on most all topics. Well I’m going to lift the veil and tell you the secret behind the next few articles coming from me: *True To Life* by Janet Folger.

A dear friend handed me this book. I winced inside, thinking, *Oh no! Not another book I have to read about things I already know!* Ha! I didn’t realize what awaited me. Published in 2000, this text is lighting up my virtual board of needed facts, candid truth, and comedic insights. Contrary to what the pro-abortionists would have you believe, *only 1 percent of all abortions are for pregnancies caused by rape or incest!* The other 99 percent of all abortions are for mostly social reasons like: she felt she was not ready for the responsibility (21%); she had concerns for how it would change her life (16%); she had relationship problems (12%); she felt she wasn’t mature enough (11%); she has all the children she

wants (8%); she felt she couldn’t afford a baby (21%). Only 3 percent of women getting an abortion did so for their own health. Another 3 percent because the baby may have health problems.”¹

Page three contains a price list for aborted fetal body parts (not for the faint of heart). Wow. I was stunned, sickened, and rejuvenated in my vigilance against this murderous practice. Janet Folger spent numerous years as a pro-life lobbyist (still is) before this writing, and can whip up an effervescent recommitment to life in a single sentence.
